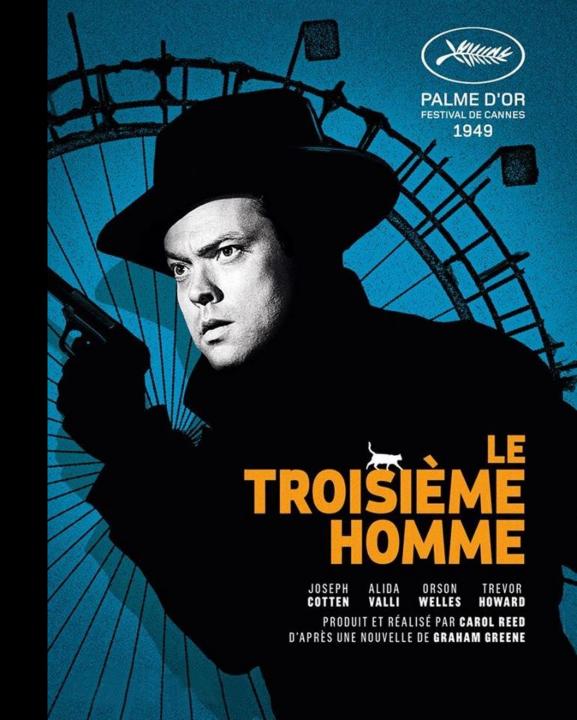

FIRST STOP, FERGUS ONTARIO!

Founded in 1992, The Film Society's mission is to preserve & exhibit vintage films that are best experienced outside the standard digital world. **Founder & Film Historian, Philippe Spurrell** believes in offering a unique experience by combining live music, theatrics, artefacts, and or guest speakers to the films. After 25 years, he has decided to spread the cinematic magic to other Canadian towns by collaborating with **Toronto-based Eight Horse Music**.

From their archive of thousands of reels of motion picture film, they are pulling out their beautiful 16mm print of the *Phantom of The Opera (1925)* starring Lon Chaney Sr. in a dark signature role that continues to thrill audiences nearly 100 years later.

Mr. Spurrell will be introducing the film in a historical context. His only fear is being interrupted by the Phantom himself who is rumoured to make an appearance on the night of the show.
